
## **RESEO Conference 2025**

## 1. Conference venue

The conference will take place between 12:30 on Thursday 23 October and 13:30 on Saturday 25 October at the <u>Estonia National Opera</u>, Estonia pst 4, 10148 Tallinn, Estonia. Please note that there are optional pre-conference sessions on the first day and post-conference sessions on the last day of the conference.

The sessions will be held at the theatre hall, White hall, Estonia Restaurant and rehearsal rooms. The Estonian National Opera team will guide you to the rooms.

Meeting point for the guided tour is at the foyer, on the first floor.

All times on the programme are local time, Eastern European Summer Time (EEST).

This is a paperless event, so no documentation will be distributed on-site. The venues are equipped with WiFi.
