1. Conference venue

The conference will take place between 13:00 on Thursday 15 October and 17:30 on Saturday 17 October at the La Monnaie / De Munt, Pl. de la Monnaie, 1000 Bruxelles, Belgium. Please note that there are optional pre-conference sessions on the first day and post-conference sessions on the last day of the conference.

The sessions will be held at the Grand Foyer (2nd floor), Fiocco (6th floor - Atelier Building), Studio 5 (5th floor - Atelier building), Atelier éducatif (1st floor). The hosting team will guide you to the rooms.

On Thursday, the meeting point for the guided tour is the entrance hall.

All times on the programme are local time, Central European Summer Time (CEST).

This is a paperless event, so no documentation will be distributed on-site. The venues are equipped with WiFi.
